



**CORRECTIONS:** (bt=beat;  $c^1$ =notated middle C.) Pn91 bt2 treble: the 2 sharps were on  $e^1$ ,  $g^1$ .



## COMMENTS:

What is the interpretation of the curved bracket in gtr36,117 etc.? Gtr142 bt1: 8th [position] not correct for d<sup>2</sup> or needed for following chords, but left for its 19th century charm.

An extra, single-sided, guitar page 3 has been supplied. You may use it to make a fold-out to eliminate the page turn to the Trio.

A blank page was inserted in the piano part to eliminate a page turn problem.

## **DEFINITIONS:**

Marcato = accented, emphasized.

Riten = ritenuto = ritardando, but with perhaps a more pronounced reduction in speed. Trio = middle section of minuet or other composition in ternary form.
